Tips for navigating your ship

| | |
|------------------|--|
| Bow | Front of the ship |
| Stern | Back end of the ship |
| Forward | Towards the front of the ship |
| Aft | Towards the back of the ship |
| Midship | The middle area of the ship |
| Port | Left side of the ship looking forward (PORT and LEFT are both four letter words) |
| Starboard | Right side of the ship looking forward |

On board Oriana the colour of the edges of the stairwell carpet will indicate where you are:

- Beige carpet** – AFT stairwell
- Blue carpet** – MIDSHIP stairwell
- Green carpet** – FORWARD stairwell

Whenever you come out of a lift on Oriana you will be facing AFT.

Cabin locator

EVEN number cabins are on the **PORT** side of the ship

(A useful cipher: LEFT, PORT and EVEN are all four letter words)

ODD number cabins are on the **STARBOARD** side of the ship

Lower number cabins are forward, or at the front of the ship

Nautical facts

Knot – one nautical mile per hour

Nautical mile – 6,080.2 feet or 1/60th of one degree of the earth's circumference (a land mile is 5,280 feet)

Guide to Stripes


 **Commodore**
1 large solid gold bar & a rising sun

 **Captain**
4 gold stripes & a rising sun

 **Deputy Captain**
4 gold stripes. Black in between stripes denotes Deck department. (Head of the Deck department)

 **Executive Purser**
4 gold stripes. White in between stripes denotes Hotel department. (Head of the Hotel & Entertainment dept)

 **Chief Engineer**
4 gold stripes. Purple in between stripes denotes Technical department. (Head of the Technical department)

 **Executive Committee**
3.5 stripes

 **Senior Officer**
3 stripes

 **Senior Officer**
2.5 stripes

 **Senior Officer**
2 stripes

 **Junior Officer**
1 stripe

 **Junior Officer**
0.5 stripes

 **Cadet**
1 horizontal stripe

 **Environmental Officer**
Green in between stripes

 **Medical Officer**
Red in between stripes

How does my Cruise Card work?

Your Cruise Card is your security pass to embark and disembark the ship, as well as your cabin door key, so it's important to look after it and keep it with you at all times. Your Cruise Card also acts as a charge card for purchases you make on board, which are automatically added to your on board account. If you haven't already done so, remember to sign your Cruise Card.

For security reasons, we recommend you keep your Cruise Card separate from your cabin number. If you misplace your card, please contact Reception (Deck 5) Atrium.
