**ITINERARY**

**Day 1**

**Arrival into Auckland**

Upon arrival into Auckland early morning, you will be met by our representative at the cruise terminal for your transfer to the Amora Hotel. The rest of the day will be spent at leisure.

**Day 2 - (B,L)**

**Full Day Tour of Auckland**

You'll be met at your hotel to start your tour today. Begin with a scenic drive to Auckland's waterfront and visit the quaint Victorian village of Parnell, Auckland's oldest suburb full of charm and quaint shops. At 196 metres high, the extinct volcano of Mount Eden offers panoramic views of the city. Continue to Villa Maria winery for a guided tour. Started in 1961, the winery started with just one man and his wife and has grown to be a global brand exporting to over 50 countries worldwide. Your tour includes wine tasting and a 2 course lunch. After lunch, visit the Auckland Museum and enjoy a guided tour viewing the renowned collection of Polynesian artefacts including a 25-metre long war canoe built in 1836. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure.

**Day 3 - (B,L)**

**Full Day Tour of Rotorua**

Embark on a full day trip to Rotorua, the thermal capital of New Zealand. Visit Te Puia – New Zealand's living Maori cultural centre. Te Puia's 60 hectare site is home to an Arts and Crafts Institute and you can enjoy an exclusive guided tour of the National Schools of Whakairo (wood carving), Pounamu (stone carving) and Raranga – a weaving workshop where Manuhiri weave a flax

memento to take home. Continue into Te Whakarewarewa Thermal Valley to see kiwi birds, hot springs, mud pools, silica terraces and geysers. Finally enjoy a picnic lunch beside the world famous Pohutu Geyser, the largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere. Return to Auckland via a scenic drive through Rotorua. On arrival in Auckland enjoy the evening at leisure.

**Day 4 (B)**  
**Departure from Auckland**

You'll be met at the hotel at the pre-arranged time by a local representative for your transfer to the airport for your onward flight.
