ITINERARY

Day I - (no meals) **Arrival into Hong Kong**

Upon your arrival into Hong Kong airport you will be met by a representative who will direct you to your coach. Transfer to the 4.5 star Royal Garden Hotel for check in (check opens at 14.00). Rest of day at leisure.

Day 2 - (B) Hong Kong/Guilin

Morning at leisure. Meet your escort at the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Guilin. Depart Hong Kong on Dragonair flight KA704 to Guilin departing at 13.55. Arrive Guilin airport at 15.20, where you will be greeted by your local escort and transferred to the Sheraton Guilin Hotel. Time permitting, enjoy a photostop at Elephant Trunk Hill en route. Check into hotel and enjoy the rest of the day/evening at leisure.

Please note flight details are correct at time of publication but are subject to change. Your main cruise luggage may be stored at the Royal Garden Hotel and will be returned to you when you return to Hong Kong. We recommend you pack a small piece of luggage for your trip to Guilin only.

Day 3 - (B, L)Li River Cruise and Evening Show in Yangshuo

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and depart at approx 9.00am with your guide for your transfer to the pier. Board your boat for a leisurely 4 hour cruise along the Li River. Enjoy a boxed lunch during your cruise. Arrive at the town of Yangshuo at approx 13.30. Disembark your river boat and transfer to your hotel via the local countryside. Check in at the Green Lotus Hotel and enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Your hotel is centrally located by the river close to many shops and restaurants.

This evening, a short transfer will bring you to the spectacular outdoor stage of the Liusanjie Night Show. Enjoy this incredible 70 minute show, performed across the Li river and combining a large scale light system, special smoke system and overwhelming sound system to produce a show in harmony with the natural landscape. Return to your hotel at approx 9.00pm.

Please note the river cruise is not private and there will be other members of the public on board.









Day 4 - (B, L) Reed Flute Cave and return to Hong Kong

Enjoy a morning visit to the Reed Flute Cave, a natural cave carved out of the karst limestone mountains over millions of years. Multi coloured lighting lights up the various stalactites and stalagmites with the highlight being the enormous Crystal Palace, used as an air raid shelter during wars. Enjoy a traditional Chinese lunch before transferring to the airport for a Dragonair flight back to Hong Kong. Arrive back in Hong Kong at approx 5.35pm where you will be met and greeted and transferred to the Royal Garden Hotel for check in. Rest of evening at leisure.

Day 5 - (B, L) Day Trip to Hong Kong Island

Your day will start with a scenic drive to Hong Kong Island via the underwater harbour tunnel, exiting onto Hong Kong Island in Central which has long been known as the heart of Hong Kong. Head inland to Victoria Peak funicular railway. The Peak tram is an experience taking you up past Hong Kong Island's skyscrapers where at the top you'll have views stretching across skyscrapers and Victoria Harbour all the way to the green hills of the New Territories.

After, head further south of the Island past Repulse Bay, one of Hong Kong's most popular beaches before climbing aboard a sampan boat for a closer look at the famous Aberdeen typhoon shelters and their old-world fishing community. End aboard the famous Jumbo floating restaurant established in 1976 as a typhoon shelter shortly after World War II. In 1952 it was converted into the restaurant it is today and famous for its Cantonese and Dim Sum food.

After lunch head to Stanley village located on Hong Kong Island's south coast. Popular with locals, expats and tourists alike, you can find a selection of accessories, jewellery and souvenirs at reasonable prices hidden in the bazaar. Or if you prefer take time to explore the villages' bars and restaurants located along the picturesque waterfront. Murray House, a Victorian-era building built in the present-day business district of Central in 1846 as officers' quarters of the Murray Barracks can be found nearby, having been relocated to Stanley during the 2000s. Tin Hau Temple, one of the oldest temples in Hong Kong is also a short walk away.

After spending time in Stanley, you'll be taken back to your hotel in Kowloon for some time to freshen up and relax before being met by your guide. A short evening walk will take you to the harbour front where you can view the Symphony of Lights show. Set around the sparkling Victoria Harbour, discover the world's largest light and sound show where buildings will light up and flicker to music. After the show, your guide will walk you back to your hotel.

Day 6 - (B) **Departure Day**

Spend the morning at leisure before your transfer to the pier to join your ship.

Please note that the order of the itinerary may vary on the day. Some activities are subject to weather conditions and will be assessed by your tour guide on the day.
